CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY NOTICE

To Robbinsville and East Windsor Township Residents

On or about (March 26, 2012?) the NJ Turnpike Authority will begin the process of replacing the Perrineville Bridge as part of the NJ Turnpike Widening Program. During the work, through traffic will be detoured along portions of Windsor Road, Sharon Road and Old York Road. The bridge replacement is scheduled to be completed and Perrineville Road re-opened to through traffic in (December 2012?).

Night-time demolition operations to remove the old bridge structure will begin on or about (April 2, 2012?) and will take approximately 2 weeks to complete. The Contractor will make every effort to minimize the noise of this operation. The demolition work over the Turnpike must be done at night in order to protect motorists and minimize traffic impacts.
